NEWS FROM THE FIELDS AND PRAISE REPORTS

Looking back to the inception of the work in Northern Ghana and how far God has brought us, it behooves us to make a joyful noise to the Lord for the consistency in the release of His grace, mercy, and help. Through His gracious and glorious interventions, He has continued to enable us accomplish much for the kingdom in the areas presently assigned to us by the Spirit.

Little by little, this gospel which is the good news of the Kingdom of God constantly is spreading among the Dagombas and Gonjas, indigenous peoples of the Northern region of Ghana, mostly Islamic and Traditionalists.

Within five years, the Lord has given us six villages and communities to establish His presence amongst these peoples—in Kusagwu, Kpatiyen, Dawoyili, Sankpala, Wanbong, and Blamposo. Our outreaches are holistic, encompassing the spiritual and physical, and impacting on these peoples in very positive ways.

For example, we have, at various times, attended to their health needs by bringing medical teams to their doorsteps. Also, in partnership with community health centres, we regularly hold health seminars and teaching classes for the indigenes in order to improve their health consciousness.

We are in education to improve their literacy levels through our primary schools and children Bible clubs, and legacy foundation programme for adults and community leaders.

GREAT MISSION CHILDREN ACADEMY

At this point, we must highlight our excitement at the prospects of Great Mission Children Academy, our primary schools. Many of the children, hitherto abandoned and left to wander the streets and the communities, have found a place of learning, character formation, and spiritual growth. Children who would not have had the opportunity to get an education are now being taught to read and write in our free schools. Close to 25 Fulani children are in these schools. Please support us in this vital project of re-shaping the future of a generation for positive community and kingdom development.

As part of our literacy drive, we have also initiated a scheme which we call "A Christian from each Family Project," and the aim is to target families through the reading project with the two-fold aim of increasing their literacy level and exposing them to the gospel.

Our other humanitarian services direct relief to the neediest in the communities, and self-employment initiatives to correct widespread poverty and promote self-sufficiency.

PALACE FELLOWSHIP

We feel strongly the Spirit's leading to start what we call "Palace Fellowship" designed for the ruling class in the communities. We are of the view that this platform will enable us penetrate the authorities and opinion leaders with information, ideas, and concepts to better their standard of life and the well-being of the communities. At the heart of this initiative is to also find an open door for their salvation and discipleship. This work is already in progress. Please keep praying for us.

NEW FIELDS

We thank God for your prayers and support for the work that has started in full force in Burkina Faso. Presently we working among the unreached people group called Kasem in a village called Dakols. The major religions are Islam and Traditional religion. Many families who before now worshipped ancestral spirits and at the same time practiced Islam are among the converts being disciplined. Through football evangelism, more than 30 youths are now ready for discipleship.

ANNUAL END-OF-YEAR RETREAT

This year end of year retreat was in two segments from December 13 – 15 held in Burkina Faso, and December 19 – 25 held in Kusawgu, Kpatiyen, Dawoyili, Sankpala, Wanbong, and Blamposo with the theme: "The Great Physician" (Jeremiah 8:22).

To the glory of God, the great physician healed many that were sick. Many souls were saved including families of Fulani herdsmen and traditional rulers. Jesus has challenged the lives of many which have become a testimony among the unbelievers.

THE REGIONS BEYOND

(2 COR. 10: 12-16)

The "regions beyond" was one powerful phrase the Apostle Paul once used to communicate his passion for lost souls, and their location. This great missionary was always pressing for the frontiers, frontiers of unreached peoples. And, every time, he would insinuate that God was behind his move.

It was not always so. After the Holy Spirit moved the leadership of the Antioch church to commission Paul and Barnabas for global evangelism. "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them", they still seemed to be directing much of their outreach energies to Jews and Proselytes (Acts 13:2; 13:16, for e.g.).

But this was to change after intense Jewish opposition. The backlash seemed to have drawn their attention backward to a passage the Holy Spirit probably was waiting for them to discover: "I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth" (Acts 13:47; quoted from Is 49:6).

The "ends of the earth" as far as global evangelism is concerned, is always with reference to the populations, cultures, and geographical locations of those who are far from the gospel or have not had exposure to it (Acts 1:8). These areas of the planet the apostle describes as the "regions beyond." Beyond where? Beyond where the gospel had already reached (2 Cor. 10: 16).

Paul made it very clear it wasn't his style neither was it biblical to pitch one's evangelism and church planting tent in territories now occupied by the gospel. The foundations of truth had already been laid there and the gospel would be extending into nearby territories and environs. A re-entry into those communities where the gospel was thriving would mean unnecessary rivalry, competition, and tension that eventually would be to the detriment of the gospel (2 Cor. 10: 12-15).

Paul's style is God's style, which also must be our style, pattern, and practice (John 10:16; Acts 1:8).

We must desist from foraying into areas and territories with a flourishing church and gospel. We must search for peoples, tribes, or cultures with no gospel or very insignificant kingdom presence, introduce them to Christ, multiply His presence, so that among those, God will take out a people for His name (Acts 15:14).

That, people of God, is the only way to achieve Matthew 24:14 and hasten the return of Christ!
