

MISSION REPORT: KYENI DELIVERANCE CHURCH INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH

REPORT DATE

7th -10th December 2023



LOCATION:

The church, Kyeni Deliverance Church International, is situated 2km from Nairobi Kitui road, near a center called Katutu. The accommodation facility used during the mission is located 8km from Kyeni shopping center.

OUTREACH ACTIVITIES:

Door-to-Door Evangelism:

- Teams visited 14 families during the evangelism campaign, engaging in personal conversations, and sharing the message of salvation. This allowed for a more intimate connection with the community members.
- Witnessed 6 individuals accepting Jesus Christ as their Savior, including 4 men, 1 lady, and a teenager boy around 13 years old. This demonstrates the impact of personal outreach on a diverse demographic.

Open Air Meetings:

- Held open-air meetings in a public space, providing an opportunity for the broader community to gather and hear the message of hope and redemption.
- Conducted successful meetings where 3 elderly men accepted Jesus, and 1 person experienced deliverance, showcasing the communal impact of the outreach.

CHALLENGES:

Instruments:

Faced challenges related to the availability and quality of musical instruments during the outreach, impacting the quality of worship and engagement.

Distance:

The logistical challenges arising from the 8km distance between the accommodation place and Kyeni shopping center affected the efficiency and planning of the outreach.

Hurting Families:

Elaboration: Encountered families dealing with various issues such as emotional distress, financial struggles, and relational challenges, highlighting the need for holistic support

PRAYER POINTS:

Poverty:

Prayed for the alleviation of economic struggles within the community, seeking God's guidance in implementing sustainable solutions and support systems.



Religion:

Lifted up prayers for spiritual discernment and unity within the community, asking for God's guidance in fostering a strong and cohesive faith community.

Witchcraft:

Prayed against any spiritual bondage or practices harmful to the community, seeking divine intervention for protection and deliverance.

Divorce:

Sought God's intervention in healing broken relationships, praying for reconciliation and the restoration of families affected by divorce.

Drunkenness:

Offered prayers for individuals struggling with alcohol addiction, seeking divine intervention for freedom from destructive habits and the establishment of support systems.

OPPORTUNITIES:

Future Evangelism Invitations:

Elaboration: Received invitations for future evangelism activities from Pastor Sammy and another pastor, indicating the positive impact of the mission and potential for ongoing collaborative efforts.

Consideration: These opportunities will be considered prayerfully, evaluating the feasibility and impact of future missions in collaboration with the invited pastors.
